Medical Device Service Tech / Tool Creator / Prototype Guy / Shop Manager / First Responder Responsible for diagnosing, rebuilding and repair of the Adaptable Arm Positioning System. The main component of the aluminum / carbon fiber system is an articulating arm that is used to immobilize a patient's arm or leg in a fixed position during surgery. My primary responsibility is to quickly assess, rebuild, re-tune and return arms that have broken in the field. My secondary responsibility is repair shop management, which includes making sure all protocols (SOPs) are up to date and within legal compliance, inventory of required parts and requisition of bio-hazard cleaning agents, welding supplies, etc. One self imposed responsibility is new tool creation/fabrication to increase my efficacy, overall efficiency and reduction of injury. I have also been asked to design and fabricate multiple prototypes to solve issues encountered during some surgeries. It's pretty cool to know that for every articulating arm that I repair, hundreds of people will reduce their pain, increase their mobility and experience a fuller, happier life.
